Tentative calendar/more fun events: Elsewhere in the newsletter you will find a copy of the tentative CKCOJ calendar through 2003. This calendar includes proposed trials and events, including more fun and social activities. New proposals include a club picnic

with games, rally obedience practices and fun match or trial, and Dancing with Dogs. Stay tuned for more details!

Restructured board meetings: You will see that the agenda for the upcoming board meeting is changed significantly in format. We hope to streamline board meetings so that we can spend our available time on the most significant issues and use other means such as the newsletter and email for routine updates. In addition, we propose to only hold full board meetings every other month. On the opposite month, there will be a short board meeting combined with a fun activity or educational speaker that will appeal to the general membership. For example, the November meeting will include a short board meeting starting at 6:30 p.m., followed by a presentation on Rally Obedience beginning at 7. We also plan to schedule the speakers or other events far enough in advance that members can block out the time on their calendars.

Organizational Development: Jim Douglas helped us identify a number of actions that would help us better function as an organization, as well as recruit and retain volunteers. These include revisions to our articles of incorporation, new insurance options, creation of job descriptions and "to do" lists for all volunteer positions, and an instructor development program. 🐕
