Revised Awards Schedule for Doggie Dollars

Current CKCOJ Policy:

13. Doggie Dollars will be awarded to volunteers as follows: \$20 for instructing or assisting a six-week class; \$3 for facilitating a practice session; \$20 per trial for both trial chair and secretary, \$5 per day for stewards; \$5 per trial for ring set-up and clean-up; \$ 5 per day for pet festival and pet photos with Santa; and \$5 per issue for production of the newsletter. Doggie dollars can be redeemed toward the purchase of memberships, classes and other goods and services as approved by the board.

Changes to CKCOJ Policy 13 as approved by the Board, January 10, 2001:

Doggie dollars be awarded to volunteers as follows:

- \$30** Instructing a six week class
- Seminar organizers
- CGC test organizer
- Trial Secretary
- Trial Chairperson

- \$25** Per instructor if a class is co-taught (up to 2 instructors - 6 week class)
- \$20** Instructor Assistant in a 6 wk class
- Practice session or Class organizer (Liaison) - 6 week session
- Annual positions as designated by the Board
- \$5** Practice session facilitator
- Per month for newsletter producer
- Per month for Web Master
- Per month for training coordinator
- Per month for Board Members
- Per day trial Photographer
- Per trial for program producer
- Per trial for set up crew (*paid regardless of entry status*)
- Per trial for clean up crew (*paid regardless of entry status*)
- Per day for stewards, timers, scribes (who has committed in advance)
- Per day for miscellaneous volunteer at trial chair's discretion
- Per day for pet festival
