FROSTY PAWS



Frosty Paws are commercially-made "ice cream" treats for dogs. I never met a dog that didn't like it. This is a homemade version which I got off the Web. This recipe uses totally different ingredients, but like its commercial counterpart, I never met a dog that didn't like it. This recipe will make about 18 Frosty Paws.

- 1 quart vanilla yogurt
- 1 medium banana
- 2 Tablespoons peanut butter
- 2 Tablespoons honey (optional)

Puree the banana in a food processor (a blender would probably work fine). Add the peanut butter and honey and continue processing until smooth. Add yogurt and process just long enough to blend all ingredients together. Place 18 small paper cups (bathroom size) in a baking pan (one 9x13 or two 8x8 work well). Divide the mixture evenly among the cups -- they will be about 1/2 to 2/3 full. An ice cream scoop or a measuring cup makes the job easier. Freeze until solid. I transfer the frozen treats to zip-lock bags for storing in the freezer.
