# Competition Novice Obedience Workshop

## January 4<sup>th</sup> - February 22<sup>nd</sup>

### Mt Jumbo Gym 10-11:30A.M.

This workshop is open to any CKCoJ member who is interested in trialing their dog in our UKC obedience trials. All degrees of experience are welcome and folks just starting out are encouraged to join.

It is a workshop versus a class situation. Everyone participating will have input into what things will be reviewed, practiced or learned. The workshop begins Saturday, January 4<sup>th</sup> at Mt Jumbo. To run for 5 consecutive weeks, followed by 2 ring run thrus prior to the obedience trial and culminating on 2/22. The weekend of March 1/2.

The workshop is offered to help motivate those who already have some background in trialing their dogs, as well as to help those just starting out. Depending upon each team's proficiency, will determine whether or not they will be ready for the actual trial.

For those planning to join us for the workshop, I have scheduled the first in a series of evening discussions at the **Mendenhall Library on 12/10 at 6PM.**

I know it is a busy time of year for all of us. It is important that you come to ensure your thoughts are heard. Since one & 1/2 hour sessions at the gym is a relatively short time to get things done with our dogs, evening discussions are essential to help facilitate momentum and focus on the things that are most important to all of us. Depending upon our needs and goals, other meetings will be planned.
