## MINUTES

### Minutes for the CKCOJ Monthly Board Meeting

**Held: Thursday November 18, 2004 6:30-8:30PM**

Riverbend Elementary School Staff Lounge

1. **Call to order** 6:32 PM. Board members present: Barb Deyell, Marty Messick, Cherie Nienhuis, Camille Stephens, Gina Vose. Club members present: Jill Grose, Vicki McLaughlin, Linda Shipman, Perry Shipman
  2. **Consent agenda**
    - a. Approval of agenda. Approved by unanimous consent.
    - b. Approval of new members. Gail Baker (family), Monica Gross, K, Linda and Kole Koski (family), Anna White. Approved by unanimous consent.
    - c. Approval of October minutes. Minor change to refer to the event for next summer as the "Combined Event" rather than the "Super Event". Following changes, approved by unanimous consent.
    - d. Acceptance of Treasurer's report. Approved by unanimous consent.
  3. **Action items**
    - a. Alternative to current club storage. Perry has looked into the purchase of an old truck to store the agility equipment in, but feels it may not be feasible at this time (still need to keep the truck somewhere). This is not a dead issue yet.
- b. Christmas Party. The annual Christmas Party and Potluck is set for December 19 2PM at Jill's house. The "Chinese Crested Gift Exchange" will happen again this year. The board suggested that we give a guideline of \$10-\$20 for the gift. Motion that the club purchase a ham to serve at the party (Marty/Cherie). Motion approved.
  - c. Ring Mats. Previous decision was to wait until free shipping was offered on the mats. Gina contacted the company and they are not going to offer that this year. Motion made to spend up to \$2000 (including shipping) to purchase 3 rolls of mats – this will provide enough material for a new ring (Barb/Cherie). After further discussion of lack of baby gates for a full agility course, motion amended to spend up to \$2500 (including shipping) to purchase 3 rolls of mats and more plastic baby gates (Marty/Barb). Approved unanimous consent. The board further discussed informing club members of this purchase to add on equipment if desired (to save on shipping). In addition, the board discussed the need to sell off surplus equipment (such as old mats and the old wooden baby gates). Some of these items could be sold to club members at a reasonable price. Vickie and Camille will look at what is in storage and what we should get rid of.
  - d. Combined Event. The early planning stages have begun. Will likely have two APDT Rally Obedience Trials on the Thursday, two UKC Obedience Trials on the Friday, then a NADAC agility trial on the Saturday and Sunday. Gina presented a budget for the event. Gina has also contacted Arlene Courtney about judging the obedience and agility portions of the event. Arlene is booked through July but may be available in August. Since the Whitehorse Woofers' agility trial will be the last weekend in August (one week later than usual), we would like to try to have this as early in August as possible (either the 4-7 or 11-14). Would like to get a Rally Obedience judge that can judge level III as many of our members can compete at that level now. Alexis has agreed to be the trial secretary for both the obedience and agility portions of the weekend, Kathy Hocker will be the Rally Trial Chair, Gina will be the Obedience Trial Chair and Barb Deyell and Judy Erickson will be the Agility co-chairs. In light of this event, the club will cancel the September 2005 Obedience Trial.
  - e. TDI & CGC Test. Marty has looked into it and can't find a TDI evaluator in town. Vicki and Marty are looking into finding an out of town evaluator to come up and do both a TDI and CGC test. We would ideally hold a CGC class prior to the test and would advertise the test to other towns in Southeast Alaska.
  - f. Behavior seminar. Linda is working out details on having Sophia Yin, DVM come up in May 2005. Linda presented a tentative schedule including some public lectures with topics such as "The Makings of an Aggressive Dog" and "Four Training Techniques to Keep Fido out of Trouble" amongst others. This schedule also includes school presentations, 13 1½-hour slots

for private consultations (location for these is yet to be worked out), a 4-hour competitive obedience workshop, and a 6-hour "Basic Dog Handling for People and their Pooches" workshop. Linda presented a tentative budget, but will find out if Sophia would be OK if not all of the private consultation slots were filled. Sophia will also do a book signing while she is here (book came out in October 2004).

- g. Spring Obedience Trials. Jill and Perry will co-chair. Linda Shipman will be chief steward. Location currently DZ and Riverbend. We are starting to look at lining up judges for spring 2006 also.
- h. Seminars for 2005. Jill has been looking into some seminar possibilities.
- i. John Rogerson is available to come up in October 2005. He can cover topics such as competitive obedience, public sessions on pet manners, and aggressive dogs. Cost is approximately \$3000 for one week (2-3 evenings plus weekend seminar).
  - ii. Agility Seminar is set for June 4 & 5, 2005 with Arlene Courtney.
  - iii. Adele Yunck (author of The Red Book) is interested in coming up to do a weekend competitive obedience seminar. She would prefer to come up in the summer months, so this could be considered for May 2006. Estimated cost would be \$3000 for the weekend.
- i. Instructor Training Seminar. Marty is interested in attending a 3-day instructor's training course in Victoria, BC in April 2005. Motion that the club pay the early bird tuition for the course (\$295 Canadian dollars), Marty will cover any additional costs, and will present what she learned when she returns (Gina/Cherie). Approved by unanimous consent.
4. **Discussion items**
- a. Alternative to current club storage (Perry Shipman). Perry has looked into the purchase of an old truck to store the agility equipment in, but feels it may not be feasible at this time (still need to keep the truck somewhere and we would have to pay for insurance, repairs, etc). This is not a dead issue yet.
  - b. Obedience Run Throughs. Jill has set these up for once per month until the trial, they are set up to break even. Details on the website.
  - c. Web Site. One of our new club members has volunteered to take over the web site. Barb and Jeanne will make the transition in the next few months.
  - d. Business Cards. We are out of club business cards. Camille will get more made at Copy Works and distribute them.
5. **Routine Updates**
- a. Correspondence. Received a letter from CBJ stating that the cost of field rental may be increasing next year. Also received a letter from AKC in regards to changes in how they will certify Canine Good Citizen Evaluators and there will now be a charge of \$35/year.
  - b. Committee Reports.
    - i. Pet Photos with Santa (Barb Deyell) Update on

planning was given, the Mendenhall mall seems very happy to have us going there this year and are helping out with advertising. So far, lots of volunteers have signed up.

- c. Classes. Perry has offered to teach another 8 week Basic Obedience Class in January. Jill will look into location availability. Marty and Gina are set up to offer Puppy K classes (6 weeks each) through May 2005.
