We discussed the need for a banner we could hang at public events and trials, and the need for a new tablecloth with the club logo as well. We also discussed the need for a new logo to meet the club's current needs, and will ask Kathy Hocker to design one. The request for the banner and tablecloth were tabled until we have a new logo.

Vicky and Jill presented a synopsis of the Katzen agility seminars and thanked the board for sending them.

Seminar updates were presented: Rogerson is on track but particulars are still being worked out; the Adele Young seminar idea was dropped due to lack of response from Ms. Young; Sandra Katzen will be asked to return about this time next year since she was so well received this year.

The next meeting will be July 28, 2005, at 6:30, location to be confirmed.

The meeting adjourned at 8:14 p.m.

Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the CKCOJ was held on Thursday, June 9, 2005, at 6:30 p.m., at the Mendenhall Public Library. The President had the chair and the Secretary, Treasurer, and Member-at-large were present. The minutes of the last meeting and the treasurer's report were read and approved.

Dee Ann moved "to approve Policy 019," which was unanimously adopted without discussion.

The president called for a vote to approve up to \$100 for Jill to buy 6 harnesses for use in the agility classes, which was unanimously adopted.

Dee Ann gave a report on insurance. We are currently paying \$200 per year for "special events" coverage for training classes. She found out from the agent that a "training class" is 1) the series: once a week for 6 or 8 weeks is one class, and 2) open to the public. A "training class" is *not* 1) each day of a class, 2) for members only, or 3) a seminar, even if there are dogs present. Members-only classes and seminars are included in the general liability premium. We discussed whether we could afford a large or total loss of our equipment, and agreed not. Coverage for \$12,000 would be \$300. Dee Ann will compile a schedule of equipment if lists and replacement costs are

HOMEMADE FROSTY PAWS

1 quart vanilla yogurt
 1 medium banana
 2 T peanut butter
 2 T honey

Puree the banana in a food processor (a blender would probably work fine). Add the peanut butter and honey and continue processing until smooth. Add yogurt and process just long enough to blend all ingredients together.

Place 18 small paper cups (bathroom size) in a baking pan (one 9x13 or two 8x8 work well). Fill paper cups to about 2/3's full. An ice cream scoop or a measuring cup makes the job easier. Freeze until solid. Transfer the frozen treats to zip-lock bags for storing in the freezer.

Rally Obedience trial, but I have a couple of things to add:

1. Many thanks to Camille for help with setup, break-down, and prizes...and especially for an outstanding job as trial secretary!

2. Rally practices will resume on July 5 and will continue every Tuesday evening until our trial on August 11th. That's five chances to practice level 1, 2 or 3 courses! Practices will be held at Glacier Valley School covered playground (which is also the site of our trial). You can pay for practices on a drop-in basis (\$5) or pay for all at once (\$20). 3. 3. Use separate entry form for each dog to be entered in a club's event.
4. Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at <https://host.securelook.com/ukcsec/tlapp.html>. TL numbers are valid for 60 days - fee \$12.00. (Fees are non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
5. Mail all completed entry forms to the Event Secretary listed under the event, unless otherwise specified.
6. Make all fees payable to the host club.
7. Obedience Trials, Agility Trials and Weight Pull events are open to all UKC recognized breeds and mixed bred dogs with a valid Limited Privilege number.
8. Obedience only: Check the box provided to request either the Veteran or Special Jump height option. Veteran dogs must be 8 years or older. Eligible dogs for Special Jump Heights are outlined in the current rules and regulations.
