Gina will have a sales table for club mugs, leashes, collars, etc. The judges' dinner will be Friday night, August 12, at the Travelodge, for all who wish to attend. The time will be announced later.

The next meeting will be August 18, 2005, at 6:30, at the Mendenhall Public Library.

The meeting adjourned at 8:21 p.m.

Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the CKCOJ was held on Thursday, July 7, 2005, at 6:31 p.m., at the Mendenhall Public Library. The President had the chair and the Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Member-at-large were present. The agenda, minutes of the last meeting, and the treasurer's report were read and approved.

The president called for a vote to approve up to \$200 for Gina to buy one new pop-up tent and \$50 for purchase of one used canopy for use at club events, which was unanimously adopted.
