member. Covered playground practice sessions were proposed to be at no charge, since the club pays so little for the space, and this was another member benefit, and break-even charges for other practice locations. The matrix was simplified by listing classes once, rather than for each class.

The liability waiver was amended slightly, and the board accepted it with one minor changes.

It was proposed that scholarships be available at the discretion of the instructor.

A timeline for classes with instructors was given. Other classes will be added as instructors are found.

Better incentives for instructors were proposed, including a choice between doggy dollars and a cash honorarium (only if it would not reduce club funds below a minimum to be established), at a rate of \$10 or DD\$15 per class session for instructors and \$5 or DD\$10 per class session for assistants. Another benefit proposed was free membership for the following year for instructors.

We want to personally encourage our colleagues to be instructors.

A generous refund policy was also proposed, with practices at the discretion of the coordinator, and classes or practices not to fall below the break-even point.

With the exception of the waiver, none of the proposals were accepted as is.

It was suggested that the next meeting of the committee be announced via the club site as open to anyone who was interested.

In the style of Rotary, Perry made a \$10 donation to the club in recognition of the hard work done by the education committee.

The annual meeting will be Saturday, October 29th at St. Brendan's church in the valley, from 5-9:00. It will be a potluck and have a Halloween theme. This is the time for policy revisions, bylaw amendments, the election of those officers whose terms are expiring (vice president and member-at-large), and awards. Marty moved that we order the new pins that we need, which was unanimously approved. We want to recognize our recently retired trial secretary, Alexis.

Policy proposals need to be to Camille by the end of September.

Vicky reported on RDO Day. The board approved the use of agility equipment and mats for the day. Kathy Hocker has agreed to donate a drawing as a prize, and the board approved DD\$50 to pay her.

Marty moved that we pay Kathy Hocker \$50 for designing our new logo, which was unanimously approved.

No correspondence was distributed.

The next UKC obedience trial will be February 17-19, 2006, at Mount Jumbo.

Marty moved that approve up to \$800 for Chicory to buy 2 agility tunnels, including shipping, which was unanimously approved.

The next meeting is September 15, at the same time and location.

The meeting adjourned at 8:32 p.m.
