**Minutes**  
**CKCOJ Monthly Meeting**  
**Thursday, September 21, 2006**  
**Valley Public Library**  
**6:00 – 8:00pm**

I. Call to order.

The September Capital Kennel Club of Juneau board meeting was called to order by Dee Ann Teseneer at 6:02 pm. Board members present were Jill Grose, Pam Nelson, George Utermohle and Vicky McLaughlin. Cheryl Jebe joined the meeting while it was in progress.

II. Consent agenda

- a. Approval of agenda brought forth discussion about the action items. There was a concern raised about changes to policy 002, an increase in membership dues. The board agreed not to table the vote on this policy as it did have an effect on membership dues to be collected at the annual meeting. The agenda was approved as submitted.
- b. The board unanimously approved new members. Welcome to new members Phil Gutleben, Mari Meiners, Mitch and Connie Deely and Tracey Dukowitz!
- c. The board approved the minutes for the August meeting submitted by Pam Nelson.
- d. The board accepted the Treasurer's report as submitted by George Utermohle. The checkbook balance is \$9,393.04 as of September 1, 2006.

III. Discussion items

- a. The new membership application submitted by George was unanimously accepted. The point was made about the annual dues increase for members would not take effect until the policy 002 was passed. If the policy did not pass, the membership dues would remain the same and the form would be amended.
- b. The location of the October general membership meeting will be at the Valley Senior Center located next to St. Paul's Catholic Church. The meeting will begin at 5:30. Pam has coordinated with CCS for the building rental. The price for the evening rental for the center is \$75.
- c. Pam Nelson and her husband will coordinate Pet Photos with Santa. The event will take place on December 2<sup>nd</sup> at Nugget Mall. The times will be announced.
- d. Review of club constitution and policies has not taken place. The person who volunteered has not reported to the board.
- e. Nominations for board positions (2). Vicky will coordinate with Pam Nelson and Sue McGregor to form the nomination committee to fill the upcoming board vacancies.
- f. The new PR position has been filled by Mara Booth – Miller. There was discussion about having Mara set a deadline for information to be posted in the news. The deadline should be reasonable to provide adequate notice for her to put out to the media. Vicky will send her the PR position description.
- g. There was a request from a club member to post public contact information on the website, specifically all board member's phone numbers and email addresses. The appropriate general contact information is the message phone and club e-mail. George has adjusted the website to make the club's e-mail address and phone number DOG – E- WAG more prominent. If instructors do not want their name, address and/or email address to be listed on the class registration form, George will post info@ckcoj.org for information and have registrations sent directly to the club post office box. Instructors should specify what they want to use when they complete the registration form for classes.

September minutes continued.....

h. Complaints were filed about the amount of Doggie Dollars paid at the UKC Obedience Trial. The policy was reviewed and Cheryl Jebe will mail the additional Doggie Dollars.

IV. Action items

- a. Review and vote on changes to policy 002. Dee Ann mentioned the annual meeting being a month away and spoke about the need to decide about the membership fee this month. She read the email objection. A motion to pass was raised and seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
- b. A review of the corrected proposal 013 was made. A motion was made to accept as read and the motion was seconded. The vote on proposed policy 013 passed unanimously.
- c. Review of new policy 022. There was discussion about how the proposed policy could be more inclusive. There are other fees incurred by the membership (ie. Rally Rep, NADAC rep/membership, Rally judge application) beyond CGC evaluator. The view of the board was the policy should be all encompassing and benefit the entire club. The idea would be to broaden the policy to include all aspects of the club. The proposal was tabled so that it could be expanded. Dee Ann, George and Vicky agreed to rewrite the proposal and submit it for the October newsletter. The vote would then take place at the October meeting.

V. Routine updates

a. Correspondence

Jill had received approval from AKC to plan a Fun Match for the Juneau Agility Club. It will be the accelerated match --- meaning only 1 match to learn if we qualify. Thanks were extended to Jill for compiling all of the paperwork and submitting it. She spent a lot of time and effort into meeting the AKC requirements!

b. Event Planning

- i. September UKC Obedience Trial – The club did receive a thank you note from Judge Tami Worley. The expense sheet was reviewed. Tami spent 3 nights at the Frontier Suites.
- ii. Patricia McConnell seminar June 2007- no new information.

VI. Next meeting date will be the Annual Meeting on October 28<sup>th</sup>, 5:30 pm at the Valley Senior Center.

VII. Adjournment was at 8:10 pm.

**Classes of Memberships**

Adult or Best Friend is a regular membership open to all persons over 18 years of age who subscribe to the purposes of the club. Regular membership includes voting privileges, a newsletter subscription, participation on email lists and eligibility for all discounts and benefits. Annual dues for the regular membership is \$25.00.

Junior or Puppy is open to all persons 10 – 18 years of age. At the “Puppy” level members receive a newsletter subscription, participation on email lists and all discounts, but are not entitled to vote. Juniors are encouraged to volunteer for suitable tasks with parental consent; however, supervision is required for ages 10 -13 year olds. Annual dues for junior membership are \$10.00.

Family or Dog Pack is available to individuals within a single household. All individuals in a family membership will have all rights and responsibilities of regular members except the family membership will have only one vote. Annual dues for the family membership are \$35.00.

Champion membership is available to individual adults or families. At the Championship level the same discounts, benefits as the adult or family membership, except two people will have votes. Champion members shall be listed in all event programs and in the newsletter. Annual dues for the champion membership are \$100.00. Up to 70% may be allocated to support areas of interest.

Membership advantages include discounted rates on public classes and “Members Only” classes, practices and seminars.


