I. Call to Order

This regular meeting was called to order at 6:40pm by Grose, President, a quorum was present.

Board Members Present: Grose, Nelson, Utermohle, McLaughlin
Members Present: Petaisto

II. Consent of Agenda

- a. Approval of the Agenda – approved unanimously
- b. Approval of Previous Minutes, July 19, 2007 – approved unanimously
- c. Acceptance of Treasurer's Report – noted on the Treasurer's report was that the column headings were changed to reflect the correct year. A new statement was provided for May that included expenses for trials in July and August. A revised financial report for the McConnell Seminar was also submitted to reflect a bill from Centennial Hall for \$401.25 that was received after the original report was submitted. Passed unanimously.
- d. Approval of New Members – no new member applications

III. Discussion Items

- a. Club Historian – McLaughlin informed the board that she had not yet completed a job description for the position of Club Historian, but that she will write a description and request for a volunteer for the position for the next newsletter.
- b. Planning of Awards Night – Via email club member Hoffman had suggested holding the Awards Night at a restaurant as opposed to a potluck event. It was discussed that a restaurant setting for the Awards Night would be awkward, as it would not allow members to move about and socialize, as well as it would potentially involve having to rent a room in a restaurant. Grose will pursue renting a facility to host the Awards Night as a potluck. Grose also offered the use of her house for the Awards Night event if the general membership feels that the cost of renting a venue for a potluck would be a hardship for the club.
- c. Ribbons – McLaughlin suggested that after each trial the chairperson should be responsible for counting how many ribbons were used and how many ribbons are left.
- d. Nominating Committee – Grose reported that the one person who was brought to her attention as possibly being interested in becoming a board member was approached about the possibility and respectfully declined the opportunity.

IV. Action Items

- a. Responsible Dog Owner Day – Nelson provided pens with the CKCoJ website that were ordered for the event. Nelson reported that a class schedule will be confirmed shortly. She hopes to be able to prepare a brochure describing the classes offered by the club as well as updating the pictures on the current tri-fold display. The event is to
