**Thursday, November 15, 2007 – Juneau Library**

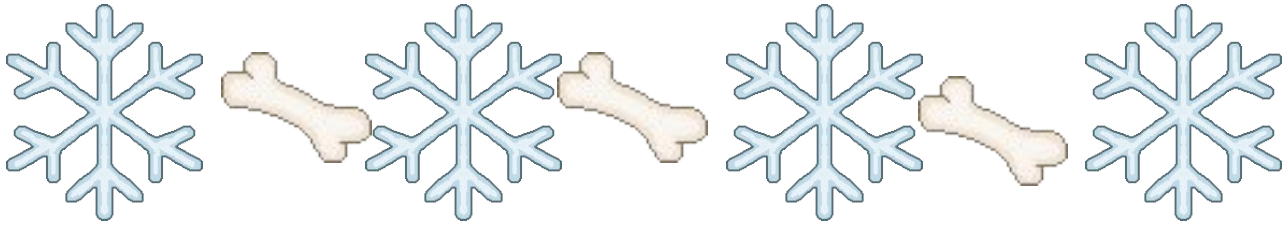
- I. Call to Order: This regular monthly meeting was called to order by Grose, President, at 6:35 p.m. Board members present: Grose, McLaughlin, Nelson, Utermohle, Barnes. Members present: Hoffman, Stephens, Felix.
- II. Consent Agenda
  - a. Approval of the Agenda – add two items; III. b. Aran Felix report on APDT Conference and V. ii. Pet Photos with Santa. Approved.
  - b. Approval of Previous Minutes, Oct. 18, 2007 – approved as written.
  - c. Acceptance of the Treasurer’s Report – the report submitted by Utermohle was approved.
  - d. Approval of New Members – none.
- III. Discussion Items
  - a. New Agility Equipment Funding – Grose proposed that the club purchase new AKC dog walk and A frame for agility. Funding would come from classes that she and a few other club members would teach. Estimated cost is \$3,500. There were some questions on storage space, will it be used in practices and so on. After a brief discussion the proposal was approved.
  - b. Aran Felix, APDT Conference – Felix provided a written report which included conference highlights and the goals she hopes to accomplish. She said there were about 1,300 participants and she had a blast.
- IV. Action Items
  - a. Donation to California Federation of Dog Clubs – after some discussion it was determined that the club needs to set up guidelines with criteria and a budget for donations.
- V. Routine Updates
  - a. Event Planning
    - i. Status Report on Agility, Rally-O and Obedience – Stephens submitted an Event Planning Cost Proposal for Hastings, Chairperson, to hold a NADAC Agility Trial in August 2008; approved. Stephens submitted an Event Planning Cost Proposal for UKC Obedience Trials to be held in March, 2008; approved.
    - ii. Pet Photos with Santa – Stephens reported on progress made. She has a Santa, photographer and volunteers to use their lap tops. She still needs a few additional volunteers. She reviewed the procedures that will be used and provided a report of estimated proceeds and expenses.
  - b. Committee Reports – none.
  - c. Correspondence – Utermohle reported he received a card from Jill Taylor announcing the birth of her son, Elias, 9/27/07, 5 lbs. 13 oz. 19”. He also received a thank you note from Aran Felix for club support on her trip to the ADPT Conference. There were a few pieces of junk mail.

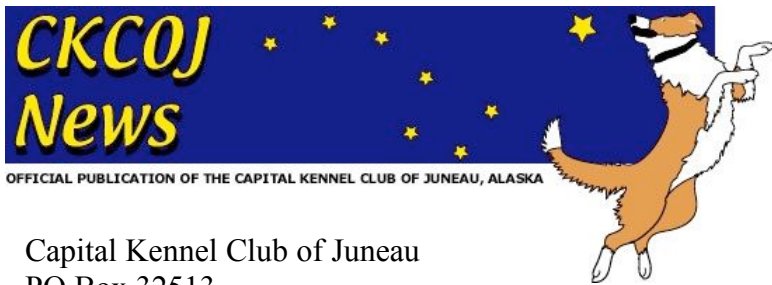

## 8th Annual "Chinese Crested" Gift Exchange

Once again, this year a gift exchange will occur at the annual Christmas Party.
