CKCoJ Monthly Meeting
Thursday, September 18, 2008 – Valley Library

- I. Call to Order: This regular monthly meeting was called to order by Grose, President, at 6:35 p.m.
Board members present: Grose, Uttermohle, Barnes, Nelson.
Board members absent:: McGowan.
Members present: Stephens, Kalbaugh, Hoffman.
- II. Consent Agenda
- a. Approval of the Agenda – approved without change.
 - b. Approval of Previous Minutes, July 17 and August 21, 2008 – approved.
 - c. Acceptance of the Treasurer's Report – the report as submitted by Uttermohle was approved.
 - d. Approval of New Members – Gina Vose, Katie and Norman Mickelson; approved.
- III. Discussion Items
- a. Cost of Storage Facility – Grose reported the cost is \$180 per month.
 - b. Annual Meeting Planning – Grose has tentative arrangement with St. Pauls for the 3rd Sunday of October at 4 p.m.; cost is \$100. Stephens will contact Gruening Park about availability and cost. The October regular and annual meeting will be held at the same place, date and time. The regular meeting will be first.
 - c. Upcoming Classes – Nelson brought up the need for additional classes which requires additional instructors. The members discussed the number of times Hazel Reynolds and Mary Meiners had assisted with previous classes. Those present appeared in agreement that this was a good method of identifying and training new instructors. Hoffman commented that she has an obedience class starting soon and she felt Mary Meiners could be the instructor.
- Notice to Members – The club is looking for event/class space where the equipment could also be stored. Contact a board member if you know of a facility.***
- IV. Action Items
- a. Rescinding of Juneau Agility Club (JAC) as a Subsidiary of CKCoJ – Grose reported she erred by changing the bylaws to rescind JAC prior to CKCoJ approval by vote. This agenda item is to correct that error. She has requested a copy of the bylaws. After a brief discussion the following motion was made.
Motion by Uttermohle, seconded by Grose
That Capital Kennel Club of Juneau rescinds its action in adopting the bylaws and other documents with formation of the Juneau Agility Club and sever all ties with Juneau Agility Club.
Passed unanimously; 7 yeas, 0 nays.
- V. Routine Updates
- a. Event Planning– Stephens submitted the event plan for the upcoming March UKC obedience trials (3). Members reviewed it, discussed the

facility cost, judge accommodations, the assumption of 8 entries; and, how trials lose money and the need to keep classes ongoing.

- b. Committee Reports
 - 1. Nominating Committee – Utermohle reported he confirmed 2 upcoming vacant positions. He contacted incumbents and approached members for interest; Sue McGowan and Camille Stephens responded with understanding.
- c. Correspondence – Utermohle displayed the mail received over the past month. There weren't any items of interest.

VI. Adjournment

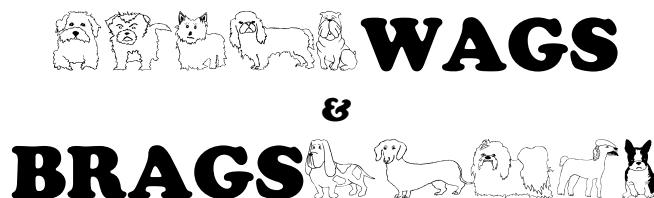
The meeting adjourned at 8:25 p.m. The next meeting will be at an as yet undetermined date and location at 4p.m.

Capital Kennel Club of Juneau Mission Statement

The purposes of the Club are to engage in activities with purebred and mixed breed dogs, to further the wellbeing of the dog, the pleasure of the owners, the responsible citizenship of dog owners, the development of skills in working with dogs and the exercise of sportsmanlike behavior.

Classes of Memberships

Adult or Best Friend is a regular membership open to each person over 18 years of age who subscribes to the purposes of the club. Regular membership includes voting privileges, a newsletter subscription, participation on email lists, and eligibility for all discounts and benefits.

Junior or Puppy is open to a person 10 – 18 years of age. At the "Puppy" level members receive a newsletter subscription, participation on email lists, and all discounts, but are not entitled to vote. Juniors are encouraged to volunteer for suitable tasks with parental consent; however, supervision is required for ages 10 -13 year olds.

Family or Dog Pack is available to all individuals within a single household. All individuals in a family membership will have all rights and responsibilities of regular members except the family membership will have only one vote.

Champion membership is available to individual adults or families. At the Championship level the same discounts, benefits as the adult or family membership, except two people within the family will have votes. Champion members shall be listed in all event programs and in the newsletter. Up to 70% of annual dues may be allocated to support areas of interest.

Membership benefits include discounted rates on public classes and "Members Only" classes, practices, and seminars.

Membership in the Capital Kennel Club of Juneau also includes membership in its subsidiary clubs, such as the Juneau Agility Club.
