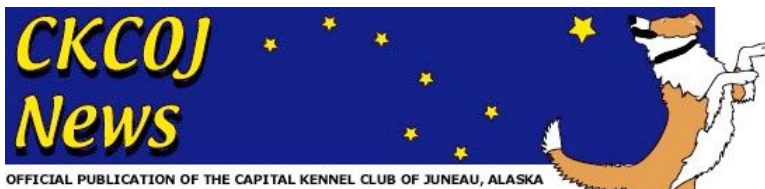
Wags and Brags Wags and Brags Wags and Brags Wags and Brags
