MT Jumbo Practices Proposed Changes for Pricing & Policy Schedule September 2009

(to include any other practice venues with similar costs)

Due to the use of doggie dollars, practices at Mt Jumbo have not been a break-even event for several years. In the past when we had ongoing public classes taught, the club was pulling in large amounts of revenue to offset the deficit for the gym rentals. During these more prosperous times the lack of revenue from gym practices wasn't an issue. With the reduction of revenue coming into the club because we have far less classes being taught and to take a proactive approach for the financial stability of the club, it is my recommendation that a moratorium on doggie dollars be put into effect so that club members pay cash only for the use of the gym.

Things to consider when making the decision are does the club want to continue to subsidize members practices or have funds available for things like trials and equipment.

Cost for Mt Jumbo is \$25.00 per hour. A 6 week practice session at \$25 per hour is \$150.00

Pricing Schedule Proposal Option A (members pay with cash only):

For the club to break even:

- 1 hour 6 week practice including transition time will cost:
- 4 or more participants \$40.00 each
- 3 participants \$50.00 each
- 2 participants \$75.00 each
- 1 participant \$150.00 each

Pricing Schedule Proposal Option B (using 50% doggie dollars):

Not necessarily break-even but be in the ballpark:

- 1 hour 6 week practice including transition time will cost:
- 4 or more participants \$50.00 each
- 3 participants \$65.00 each
- 2 participants \$95.00 each
- 1 participant \$185.00 each

Drop in cost \$10 when possible. (check with coordinator for space availability).

1/2 hour sessions may be arranged. Cost will be prorated using the above price schedules. Individuals working on their own should be prepared to set up or break down equipment when necessary.

In cases where an individual member/s needs use of 1/2 the gym for practicing utility exercises space can be reserved. However, members must work together to arrange who

will practice together and all participants must be in agreement of how they will split the gym rental. The coordinator may help to find a suitable arrangement but is not responsible for finding practice partners. Reservations for these practices will be based upon the stated rates.

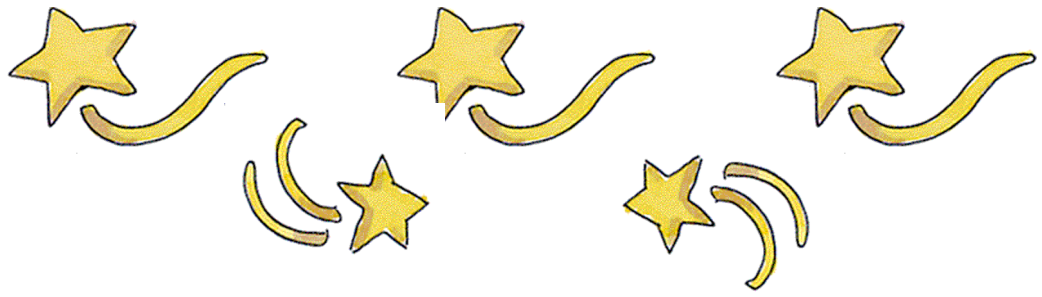
Since the cost for each individual is based upon the number of participants, commitments by all individuals need to be honored so that the club or other participants do not have to pick up the difference once the cost for practices has been announced.

Recommendation is to ask for commitments via email with a deadline, the coordinator then sets the cost based upon commitments and lets individuals scheduled know the price for their practices.

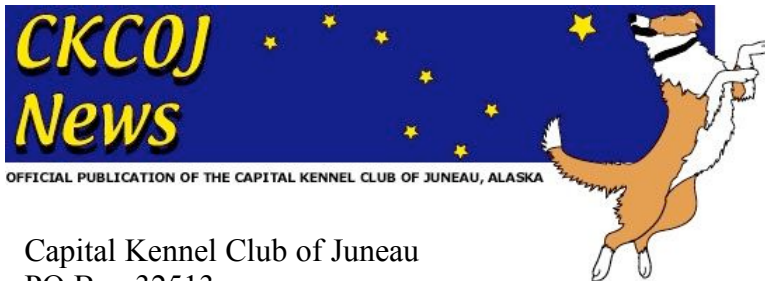
To accommodate those that know in advance that they will not be able to attend a practice on a particular date, gym practices will be prorated for all participants to cover the cost of the gym. There will be no credits given for unscheduled missed practices.

Whatever decision is made for the pricing schedule, all other new policy changes will go into effect September 2009.
