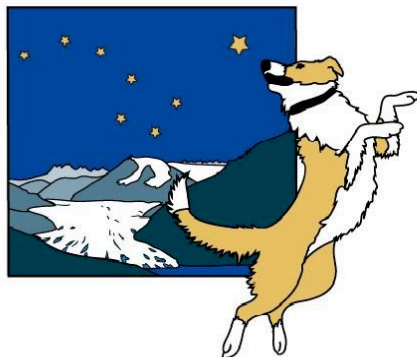

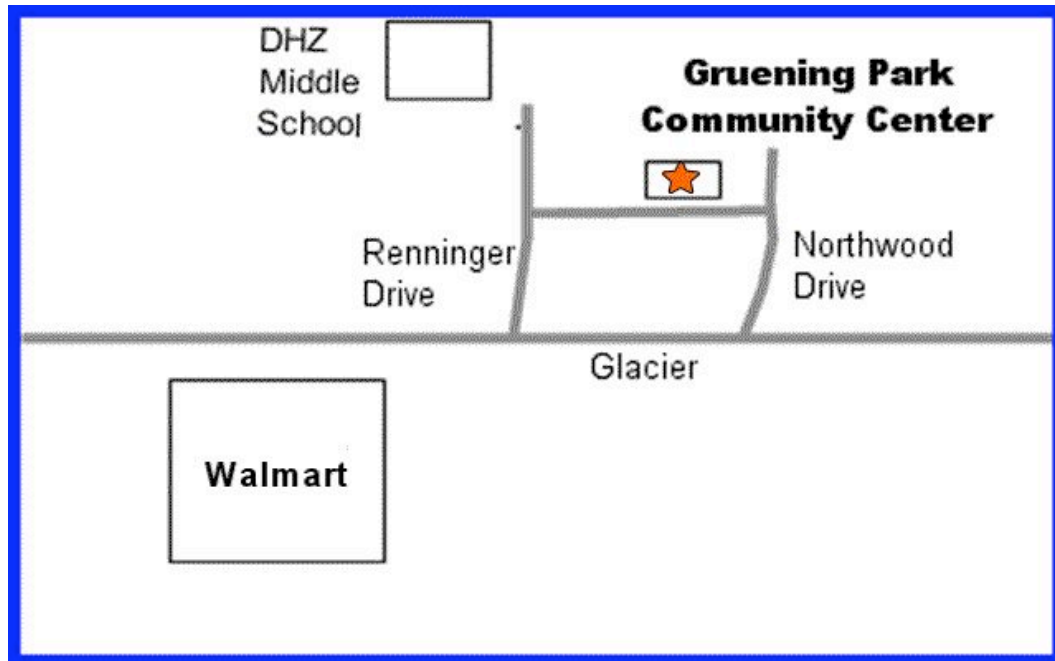

VIII. **Call to Order** -- 6:35pm. Board Members present: Jill Grose, George Utermohle, Sue McGowan, Camille Stephens. Other club members present: Hazel Reynolds, Marty Messick

IX. Consent Agenda

X. Discussion Items

- A. Annual Meeting – Planning. Details to be finalized for publishing in September newsletter. Jill will coordinate the award certificates and pins. She will post a request for member accomplishments on ckcoj-announce. Camille will submit information on the annual meeting for the September newsletter and will post on ckcoj-announce.
- B. Elections – Update from Nomination Committee. Slate of candidates to be published in September newsletter. Sue McGowan reported that the committee has not yet found any candidates for the upcoming election, but they are still waiting for a response from at least one member.

XI. Action Items

- A. Saturday gym practices (Susan Hoffman) – report from August 1 meeting. Susan was not available to report on the meeting, but did submit a report via email, including a request to purchase timers for the practices (attached). Request approved for a total of up to \$40, U/C.
- B. Proposal to attend APDT Conference (Hazel Reynolds) – Hazel presented a proposal for the club to reimburse her expenses to attend the APDT Conference (estimated at \$1,963.00) in exchange for teaching as many classes as necessary to bring in \$4,000 in revenue. She proposed that the club reimburse her in one lump sum AFTER she teaches the classes. Jill Grose raised concern about that arrangement and suggested reimbursing Hazel a portion of the funds after each class she teaches. After discussing various options, the members present agreed that the agreement should specify reimbursing Hazel in an amount equal to 50% of the gross revenue from each class she teaches after attending the conference until the terms of the agreement are satisfied. For purposes of document the agreement for future boards, Hazel will revise her proposal as a signed agreement between the club and herself (revised proposal attached). The proposal will be published in the newsletter for review and comment by the club membership. The proposal will be taken up for action at the

I would like to attend the Association of Pet Dog Trainers (APDT) Conference, from October 21-25, 2009, in Oakland, California. I have attached a list of classes/seminars that I am interested in attending at the conference. My intention is to further my knowledge in order to be able to directly benefit the CKCoJ by teaching classes above the puppy kindergarten level. These classes would be Puppy-K, possibly Basic Obedience, Beginning Rally, Canine Good Citizen, and perhaps other classes that I may learn about at this conference. I will also pay the membership fee to join APDT of \$100.00.

Hazel Reynolds will pay the various costs to attend this conference, as follows:

- 1) Attend the Association of Pet Dog Trainers (APDT) Conference, from October 21-25, 2009, in Oakland, California: including airfare, hotel and conference fees; the breakdown of fees to be reimbursed by CKCoJ is as follows:

Airfare, Juneau to Oakland and return	= \$ 634.00
Hotel, \$139/night x 6 nights	= 834.00 (special ADPT conference rate, with a number of rooms blocked out for attendees)
Conference fee	= <u>495.00</u> (conference fee for ADPT members)
Total	\$1,963.00

- 2) Upon returning to Juneau, give a summary report of the conference to CKCoJ board members at the regular meeting November 19, 2009.
- 3) Teach as many classes as it takes to bring in double the amount of \$1,963, or \$4,000 in gross revenues to CKCoJ, within three years or less.

The CKCoJ agrees to a reimbursement schedule as follows:

- 1) 50% of gross revenues per class taught by Hazel Reynolds, exclusive of "Doggie Dollars," until the \$1,963.00 amount is reached.
- 2) If Hazel Reynolds is co-instructor of a class, reimbursement will be pro-rated in proportion to the number of co-instructors.

I realize that I'm lacking in knowledge and experience, however, I truly want to learn more and to be able to be a better teacher. I do feel that this conference will allow me to learn a lot in a short amount of time, so that I can benefit the club sooner rather than waiting another year. Also, I feel that I need more formal instruction than just what I've learned from all of you and my self-study. I have heard during my Puppy-K classes that people do want additional training for their dogs after the initial socialization and basic training concepts and at this time, CKCoJ does not offer anything like that.

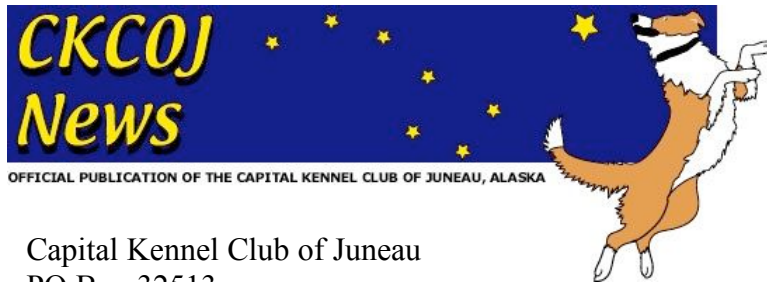
