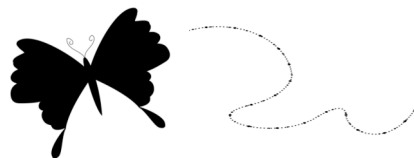

DRAFT MINUTES
CKCOJ MONTHLY MEETING

March 18, 2010

Downtown Public Library, Small Conference Room, 6:30 pm

- I. Call to Order: 6:33pm; Board members present: Sandy Harris, Camille Stephens, George Utermohle, Mike Higgs, Sue McGowan; other members present: Marty Messick, Susan Hoffman

- II. Consent Agenda
 - A. Approval of the Agenda: approved with additional items Camille Stephens, F., Mike Higgs, G., under III. Discussion Items and Sue McGowan, A., Camille Stephens, B. under IV. Action Items; U/C = Unanimous Consent
 - B. Approval of Minutes from previous meeting- February 18, 2009: approved U/C with corrected spelling of J. Etheridge
 - C. Acceptance of the Treasurer's Report- approved U/C
 - D. Approval of new members- Kate Walters, Kathleen Wiest (returning member): approved U/C

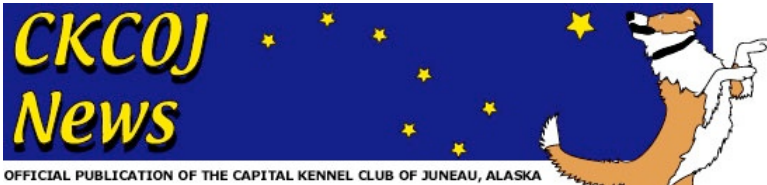
- III. Discussion Items
 - A. Adding definition of terms/glossary (S. Harris)- carryover: Harris presented the latest version of the glossary with the most recent additions; Harris will continue to add/update the document as it is considered a "work in progress" and will require periodic maintenance; George Utermohle will post on the club website
 - B. Keeping a "running" list of changes to be decided upon at annual meeting- carryover: Sue McGowan, as club secretary, was directed to keep a list of items to be discussed at the CKCoJ annual meeting in October- this item B. to be removed from monthly agenda
 - C. Set schedule for CKCoJ trials- carryover: to be added to the list of items to be discussed at the annual meeting
 - D. Current requirements at Pioneer's Home; CKCoJ interest in Therapy Dogs International (TDI)- carryover: S. Harris reported on the current requirements for bringing dogs into the Pioneer Home and Wildflower Court; the Pioneer Home requires current vaccinations, dogs must be on-leash; Wildflower Court requirements are dogs must be current with vaccinations, on leash and all dogs are required to take a temperament test.
Marty Messick led a discussion about Therapy Dog International (TDI) qualification and testing in Juneau and brought up a discussion she'd had with a member of a Port Townsend (Washington) kennel club and the possibility of being able to "umbrella" the teaching and testing under that club's auspices to provide Juneau people the opportunity to qualify their dogs; the main distinction between a CGC-certified dog and a TDI-certified dog is that insurance covers a TDI dog; additional discussion about

whether there is enough interest in Juneau for having TDI certification; Marty will follow-up with more information and report back- carryover

- E. Draft Annual Scheduling (preplan typical annual schedule such as board meetings & trial planning)- Mike Higgs notified the board that he will be on work-travel throughout the summer and may miss several scheduled board meetings; discussion about transferring Mike's duties as treasurer to other board members when he is away; when Mike is away, he will give Camille the mailbox key and the check book; discussion about when to hold next meetings (May/June) due to conflicts- not resolved at this meeting- board members will discuss via e-mail
 - F. Club practices: Camille Stephens thinks it's time for the board to revisit scheduled practices and fees- general discussion about how best to do that (see next item G.)
 - G. Class fees, policy update: Mike Higgs thought this item should be combined with above item F. for discussion; Susan Hoffman gave an overview of how the Mt. Jumbo practices are set up; general discussion on how to meet people's expectations for practices, fees charged, etc., the decision was made to form a committee to possibly update the above: Susan Hoffman, Mike Higgs offered to serve on the committee- carryover

Gift Certificate to Lisa Kramer, DVM: Sue McGowan requested board approval for Hazel Reynolds to not charge Lisa Kramer for her participation in the upcoming Manners class that Reynolds will teach, since Dr. Kramer has volunteered her time to speak at all of the PuppyK classes for Reynolds- approved U/C
 - B. Camille Stephens requested board approval to purchase additional Trial forms- approved U/C

 - 1. Obedience/Rally: Trial set for April; Jill will be asked to touch base with the judge (Terry K?) to make sure she is on track to come to Juneau and report back via e-mail with an update
