**DRAFT MINUTES
CKCOJ MONTHLY MEETING
April 15, 2010**

Downtown Public Library, Small Conference Room, 6:30 PM

- I. Call to order at 6:35 PM; Board members present: Camille Stephens, Mike Higgs, George Utermohle, Sandy Harris. No other club members present.

- II. Consent Agenda
 - A. Approval of the agenda with two additions. 1) Discussion of purchasing a cart to haul mats added by CS and 2) Discussion about reviewing the price structure of classes offered by CKCOJ added by MH.

 - B. Approval of the minutes from the previous meeting – March 18, 2009: Approved without objection.

 - C. Acceptance of the Treasurer’s Report: Approved without objection.

 - D. Approval of new members: Family application for Jennifer Mannix, Chris Weixelman, and Nicole Mannix approved without objection.

- III. Discussion Items
 - A. Adding definition of terms/glossary to website- the glossary is due to be posted soon by George

 - B. Interest in Therapy Dogs International – carryover.

 - C. Draft Annual Scheduling- **A proposal was made to discuss an annual events calendar at the next Annual Meeting. The Annual Meeting is a good venue for setting goals for the types and numbers of events to be held over the next year. An agenda item for the membership to review the events of the past year and set goals for the year ahead will be added to the Annual Meeting Agenda as a discussion item by the Secretary.**

D. Discussion of the price structure for CKCOJ classes.

1) There have been questions about when new members are eligible to receive the "member rate" for classes. The current policy states that new members become eligible for the lower rate after the board has approved their application for membership. Mike will submit a proposal for a revised policy to be discussed at the next meeting.

2) The prices charged for enrollment in CKCOJ classes have not been reviewed and/or changed in a number of years. Class fees are not set in policy and could be changed to be based- at least in part- on the number of enrollees or the expenses for the facility. The fees could also be raised overall. A committee to look at class fees already exists. Susan Hoffman and Mike Higgs are members of that committee. They will look into this and report back to the board.

E. Camille Stephens and Pat Kalbaugh are requesting authorization to purchase a cart to haul mats. Home Depot has a suitable cart for \$65. Majority consent was given to purchase the cart.

V. Routine Updates

A. Obedience/Rally: The judge for the trials scheduled April 23, 24, and 25 will arrive in Juneau on April 23. Pat Kalbaugh is coordinating the hospitality. Judging will begin about 1 hour later than planned on Saturday and Sunday because the facility is not available earlier. Camille will send an email to the membership to let them know. Pre-entry times will be rearranged to accommodate the scheduled availability of the facility.

B. Agility: Begins May2. The agility class may share the field at Melvin Park with a hooper class. Mike Higgs will look into planning an agility trial this summer.

C. CGC: Only two people have signed up. More advertising will go out.

D. Choose -to -Heel: The class was well attended and well received.
