DRAFT MINUTES
CKCOJ MONTHLY MEETING
August 19, 2010
Downtown Library, Small Conference Room, 6:30 pm

- I. Call to Order at 6:41pm; board members present: Camille Stephens, George Utermohle, Sandy Harris, Sue McGowan; board member absent: Mike Higgs; other members present: Hazel Reynolds, Jill Grose
- II. Consent Agenda
- A. Approval of the Agenda: approved by Unanimous Consent (U/C), with the following additions: Under III. Discussion Items, Jill Grose added D. Obedience Entries; under III. Discussion Items, Hazel Reynolds added E. Update (with regard to) Community Schools Brochure; under III. Discussion Items, Camille Stephens added F. Judges Contract Template; under IV. Action Items, Hazel Reynolds added B. CKCoJ posters.
 - B. Approval of Minutes from previous meeting- July 15, 2010: approved by U/C.
 - C. Acceptance of the Treasurer's Report dated July, 2010: approved by U/C, with some additional changes suggested by Camille Stephens to reflect current information with regard to the 2010 Reynolds Agreement- possibly a separate accounting sheet showing amount left on contract, amount paid by CKCoJ, check numbers, etc., with Reynolds providing her individual class spreadsheets as back-up.
 - D. Approval of new members: Patricia Turner Custard, approved by U/C .
- III. Discussion Items
- A. Annual Meeting- early planning: location/format: annual meeting to be held October 3 at Gruening Park clubhouse, from 4pm to 8pm; general discussion about whether to combine the regular October meeting with the annual meeting- no, officers will be selected for the upcoming year at the annual meeting, awards will be given out, then potluck- keep the meeting informal; Camille will follow-up with ordering awards (NADAC, UKC, CGC pins) and will send an e-mail for the September newsletter; the CKCoJ regular meeting will happen as usual, the 3rd Thursday in the month (October 21)- Sue McGowan will schedule the room.
 - B. Annual Board Elections- 2 positions; report from election committee: Sandy Harris reported that since Camille Stephens has agreed to continue on the CKCoJ board, only one other person was contacted and that person (Jamie Criss) indicated she was interested- Sandy will confirm with Jamie.
 - C. Doggie Dollars and membership fees- carryover: George Utermohle offered that probably the first thing to do is to identify the issues involved- after some discussion it was decided to table this issue until the regular October meeting to allow plenty of opportunity for people to comment. Carryover
 - D. Jill Grose: brought up the fact that lately CKCoJ has not been allowing the 'same dog, same trial, different classes' discount like the club has in the past; after discussion, it was agreed to reinstate the discount for upcoming trials- the trial license application and trial premium will be amended to reflect the discount.
 - E. Hazel Reynolds: updated the information she had previously received from the Community Schools director and explained that adding CKCoJ class information into the Comm. Schools brochure is allowed only if the class is taught for Community Schools, with Comm. Schools paying the teacher to teach; Reynolds offered her opinion that putting an ad in the brochure would not necessarily be cost-effective and the plan was abandoned.
 - F. Camille Stephens: Judge's Contract Template developed by Patti Kalbaugh and Camille Stephens to be discussed at September meeting. Carryover

IV. Action Items

- A. Long-term Agility equipment needs- (1 tunnel, tunnel bags/snuggies, winter contact rubberizing, hoops, gates, tire and weaves) carryover: ref. document (*Long Term Agility Equipment Planning*) sent by Mike Higgs to board members prior to this meeting. Jill Grose spoke to the issue of purchasing a new tunnel, saying the club does not need a new one, as she owns one that is currently being used and is stored at her residence; Jill also spoke about rubberizing certain Agility equipment (the A-frame, the Dog Walk, the Teeter) to increase safety for the dogs- Jill also noted she had gotten a quote for rubberizing from a company in Phoenix, which included shipping, for around \$400 (cheaper than the other quotes) and since the process of rubberizing takes quite a long time, Jill suggested the club approve \$400 and she will move forward so this can be accomplished in a timely manner- Camille asked for a motion to be made for Jill to spend up to \$400 rubberizing and shipping the above-listed equipment- Sue McGowan made the motion, seconded by Sandy Harris- approved by U/C. The remaining items on Higgs's list will be carried over for discussion in September. Carryover
- B. Hazel Reynolds: displayed samples of posters she made and asked board approval to move forward with putting the posters at various locations to advertise club classes and other events. OK'd by the board. Camille Stephens turned over a box of CKCoJ business cards to Reynolds for distribution at the Southeast Alaska Animal Medical Clinic.

(a) Future Obedience/Rally Trials: Camille Stephens presented the cost/expenses proposal for the President's Day (February, 2011) Obedience and Rally trial; the judge has tentatively been secured, with Jill Grose as Trial Chair. and Patti Kalbaugh as Trial Secretary; George Utermohle made a motion to approve the proposal, Sue seconded, passed by U/C.

2. Agility: Jill Grose gave the update as "Too hot, but we did it."

3. Classes/Practices- current classes/practices and plans for future classes/practices: Camille Stephens mentioned that Mt. Jumbo practices will begin in the near future. Hazel Reynolds commented that she is finishing a PuppyK class (the last class will be next Tuesday) and will start another one in November- Jill requested the November dates as soon as possible to give to Community Schools, Hazel will e-mail the dates to Jill.

4. CGC- Class and Exam- update: Sue thanked George Utermohle and Sandy Harris for assisting with the CGC tests, with George and "Otto" helping on both test nights.

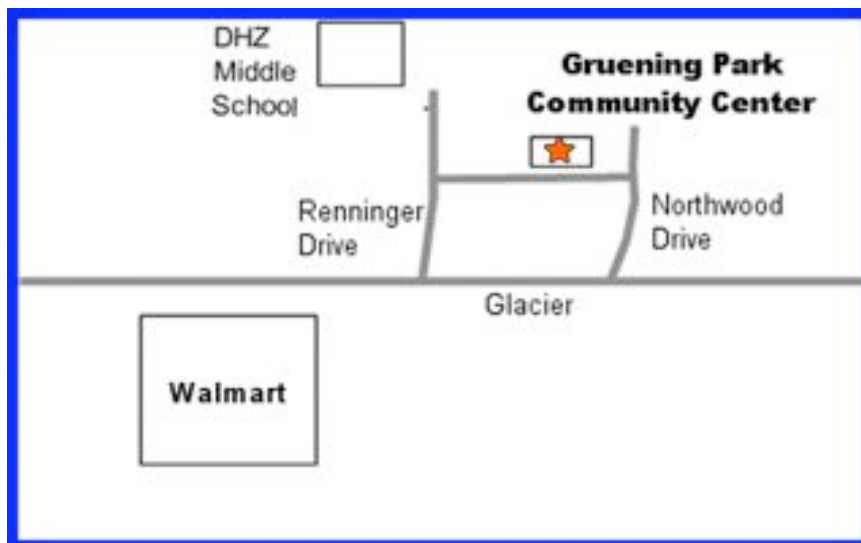


2010 Annual Meeting, Potluck and Awards

beginning at 4pm

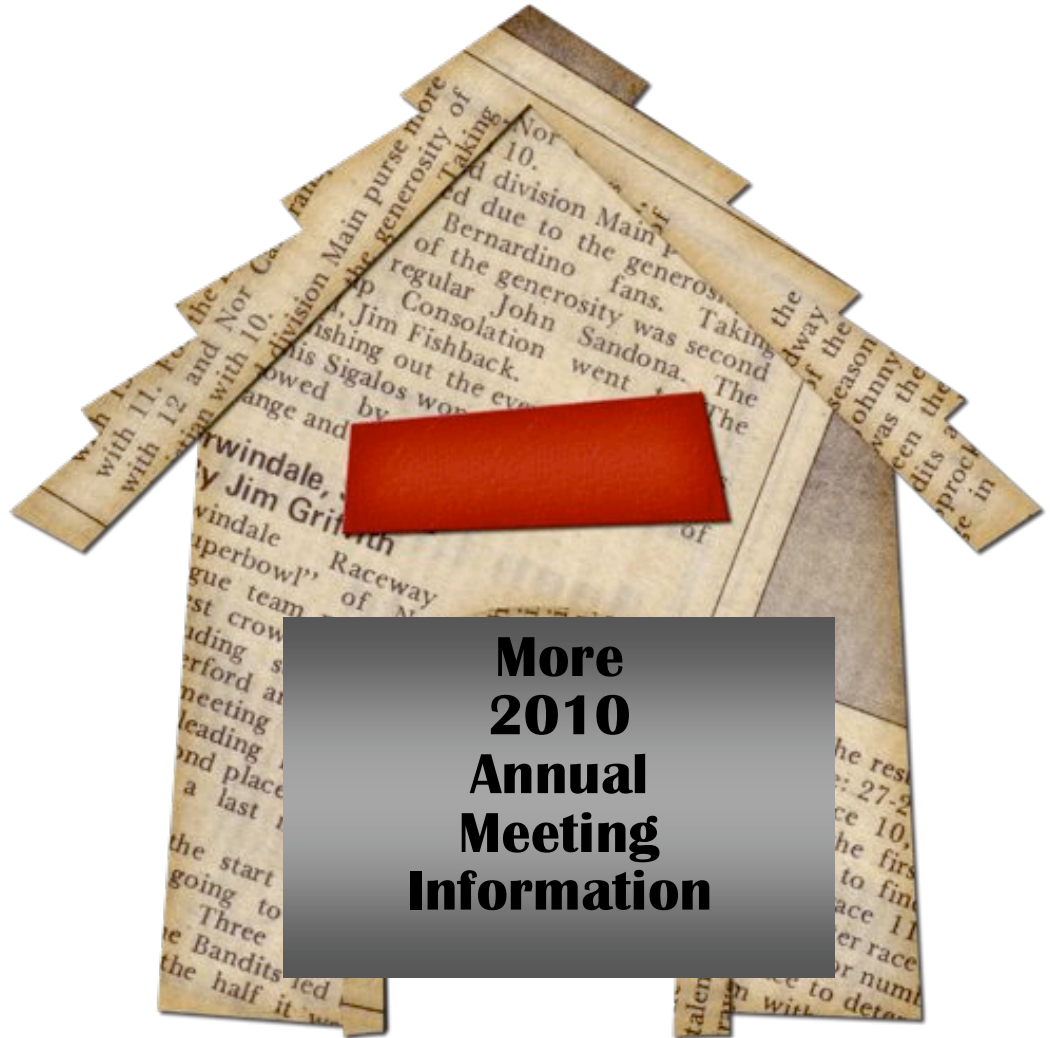
At the meeting, a very nice title pin is presented for UKC obedience and rally titles,
