- I. Call to Order: at 6:33pm. Board members present: Camille Stephens, Sandy Harris, Mike Higgs, Sue McGowan, George Utermohle. General member present: John Sivertson. Interested party: Leslie Peters.
- II. Consent agenda
  - A. Approval of the agenda: Mike Higgs added D. Agility Update to III. Discussion Items; Camille Stephens added B. Renting CKCoJ mats to the Flyball club to IV. Action Items. The agenda was then approved by Unanimous Consent (U/C), with additions as noted.
  - B. Approval of the minutes from previous meeting, 7/21/2011: correction to minutes of 7/21/2011- corrected Perry ~~Smith~~ to Perry *Shipman*; minutes then approved by U/C.
  - C. Acceptance of the treasurer's report: Mike Higgs noted that both Reynolds contracts for reimbursement are now complete; treasurer's report approved by U/C.

  - C. Flyball: Leslie Peters (founder and president) submitted a proposal from the Juneau Flyball Club (JFC) proposing that the Capital Kennel Club of Juneau absorb the Juneau Flyball Club. A work group was formed to study the proposal and report back to the board- work group members are Mike Higgs, Sue McGowan and Camille Stephens.
  - D. Agility Update: Mike Higgs reported on a meeting held two weeks ago that was attended by club members interested in continuing with Agility activities. Discussion centered on the future of Agility and finding people to help with ongoing training for handlers and dogs. Sherry Jans and Inga Petaisto have volunteered to help with training; also, suggestions included setting up a video training system throughout the winter months.

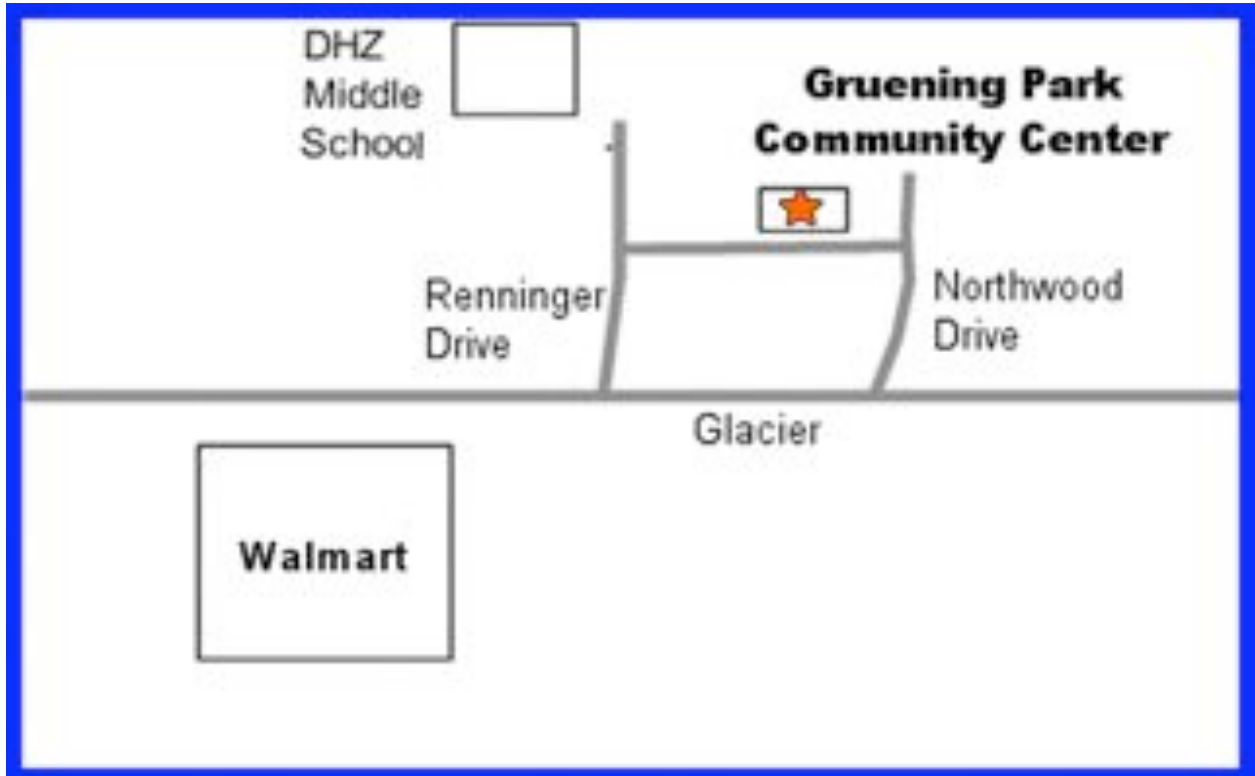

- I. Call to Order: meeting called to order at 4:35pm- food recess at 4:39pm- meeting resumed at 4:49pm. - II. Establish Quorum (50% of members): yes.
- III. Approval of Agenda: approved as drafted.
- IV. Election of Officers: one potential candidate for office withdrew (Jamie Criss); Camille Stephens and Sue McGowan agreed to serve for another term and were reelected by acclamation. It was agreed by the board that there would be no changes to current board positions.
- V. Approval of 2009 Annual Meeting Minutes: Sue McGowan moved the 2009 annual meeting minutes be adopted; George Utermohle seconded the motion. Approved by unanimous consent (U/C).
- VI. Annual Treasurer's Report: approved by U/C.
- VII. President's Report

### HOW TO USE THIS ENTRY FORM:

#### 1. Licensed Conformation classes consist of:

**A. Regular Classes. Classes for intact dogs:** Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Intermediate (Senior) (2 yrs., under 3 yrs.); Adult (3 yrs. and up); Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Champion; and Grand Champion.

**B. Altered Classes. Classes for altered dogs.** Altered Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Altered Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Altered Intermediate (Senior) (2 yrs., under 3 yrs.); Altered Adult (3 yrs. and up); Altered Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Altered Champion; and Altered Grand Champion.

**C. Junior Showmanship Classes. Consist of:** Pee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.); Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 8 yrs.); Novice Junior, Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.); Novice Senior, Open Senior (13 yrs., under 18 yrs.)

2. All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC® Entry Form". You may use one entry form to enter the same dog in more than one activity on the same weekend.

3. Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.

4. Mail all completed entry forms to the Event Secretary listed under the event, unless otherwise specified. Make checks payable to host club.

5. Obedience Trials, Agility Trials, Rally Obedience Trials, and Weight Pull events are open to all UKC recognized breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Limited Privilege number. The Coursing Aptitude Test is open to all UKC registered and Mixed bred dogs with a valid Limited Privilege number.

6. **We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:**

- Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at [www.ukcdogs.com](http://www.ukcdogs.com) or call the Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)

- **All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Limited Privilege number.**

- All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.

- To be eligible to enter into the Breeder/Handler class, you must be one of the breeders of record, or a member of the immediate family of one of the breeders of record. Immediate family includes: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, brother or sister, so long as the handler is not a professional handler as defined by UKC Rules and Regulations.

All events are held under the Official Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc.
