Five new Canine Good Citizens certified in Juneau.

Five Juneau dogs successfully completed their certification as a Canine Good Citizen. The 5 new Canine Good Citizens and their handlers are: Dugan, a Pug, and Jamie Criss; Truly Noel, a King Charles Cavalier Terrier, and Destiny Sargeant; Sam, a golden doodle, and Mari Meiners; Breezy, an Australian Shepard, and Diana Higgs; and Gidget, a terrier mix, and Aran Felix.

Testing for the CGC certification was conducted at Riverbend Elementary School commons on Saturday, February 4. The evaluator for CGC the test was Marty Messick. In preparation for the Canine Good Citizen test, each of the dog and handler teams completed a 3 week course to familiarize themselves with each of the elements of the test. The CGC preparation class and test were facilitated by George Utermohle.

Many of the new Canine Good Citizen teams will continue their training in order to become certified therapy dogs thru Therapy Dogs, Incorporated.

Capital Kennel Club of Juneau (CKCoJ) MONTHLY MEETING

January 19, 2012

Downtown Library, Small Conference Room, 6:30pm

I. Call to Order: Vice President Camille Stephens called the meeting to order at 6:34pm. Board members present: Sue McGowan, Mike Higgs, Camille Stephens. Board member absent: Sandy Harris. General members present: Hazel Reynolds, George Utermohle.

II. Consent agenda

- A. Approval of the agenda: Camille suggested the board review the items on the agenda to carryover those items that will require more discussion than there is time for at this meeting. The agenda was then approved by Unanimous Consent (U/C).
- B. Approval of the minutes from previous meeting, 12/15/2011: approved by U/C.
- C. Acceptance of the treasurer's report: approved by U/C.
- D. Approval of new members: Destiny Sargeant, Alicia Bishop approved by U/C.

III. Action Items

- A. Board vacancy (Treasurer): Mike Higgs offered to take over the Treasurer's position, but first, he would like to be able to familiarize himself with the reporting system set up by the previous treasurer. Mike will give the board his final decision at the February 16th meeting. Mike's current board position of Member At-Large would then become vacant and need to be filled. **Carryover**
- B. New Doggie Dollar Coordinator: **Carryover**
- C. Proposal to purchase indoor training mats from Inga P. for \$350: **Carryover**
- D. Class discount for new GHS adoptions: Hazel Reynolds presented a certificate for a \$30 discount of the price for a Puppy K, or Manners class, for those people who provide proof of adoption from the Gastineau Humane Society- approved with no objection.

 - 2) Agility workshop in August: *Distance and Discrimination*, taught by trial judge Susan Perry, a 4-hour workshop-need 6 dogs, fee either \$80 per dog (will accept Doggie Dollars), or \$60 per dog (no Doggie Dollars)- approved with no objection.
