December 20, 2012

I. Call to Order: 6:31pm. Board members present: George Utermohle, Sandy Harris, Carol Lemon, Mike Higgs, Sue McGowan. General members present: Hazel Reynolds.

II. Consent agenda

- A. Approval of the agenda: Mike Higgs added B. NADAC membership and C. UROC Ribbons to III. Action Items; also G. Flyball letter (update) to IV. Discussion Items. Agenda with additions, approved by Unanimous Consent (U/C).
- B. Approval of the minutes from previous meeting, 11/15/2012: approved by U/C.
- C. Acceptance of the treasurer's report: approved by U/C.
- D. Approval of new members: no new members to approve.

III. Action Items

- A. Date for special meeting to discuss fee matrix- Mike (Carryover): Mike present the Q&A document he will distribute to members interested in participating. The questions and answers were developed from various members over the past year. Meeting date: January 9, downtown library, large conference room.
