I. Call to Order: 6:35pm. Board members present: Mike Higgs, George Utermohle, Carol Lemon, Sandy Harris, Sue McGowan. General members present: none.

II. Consent agenda

- A. Approval of the agenda: Deleted "Dog Law presentation (Carryover)" from agenda. Mike Higgs changed III. Action Items, A. Fee matrix meeting to V. Routine Updates/Reports; Mike Higgs added C. Ribbons to IV. Discussion Items, and D. Insurance update (George Utermohle). Agenda with additions was then approved by Unanimous Consent (U/C).

- D. Insurance update- George Utermohle: as discussed last month, several items of club property were combined in order to reduce insurance cost. George noted that the City and Borough of Juneau (CB/J) will have to be named as Additional Insured if the club decides to install a storage van at Melvin Park. (Carryover)
