"Heeling Focus Workshop"

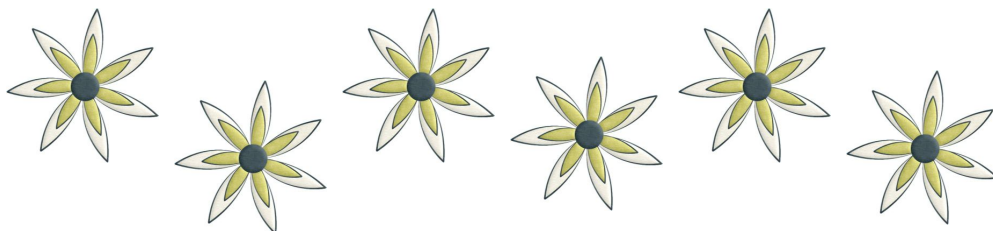
*Have you ever wanted to learn

from an expert?*

Well, here's your opportunity. Coming May 3rd Ruthann McCaulley, will be teaching our 'Heeling Focus' workshop & will be judging the Rally Trial on Saturday & Sunday.

Ruthann was raised dogs. Started training at a young age in conformation, has owned at least one dog from every group except sporting. Competes in obedience, agility and Rally since 2000. Her dogs consistently ranks in the top three in obedience, agility and a one in obedience dog. She also plays with freestyle, flyball, earth dog, treibball and nose work. She is a CGC Evaluator. She writes for 'Front and Finish' (www.dogsselftrained.com), Western Wishes and SerpenTEAM. She wrote "Going it Alone"; "Doodle By Design"; and "Rally All Around". She teaches weekly Rally classes and has a Youtube demonstrating AKC Rally.

This workshop will consist of an intro to choose to heel; look at that; no sniff/my space; reorienting; parallel & 1-2-3 games; and impulse control. Items she suggests bring include a hungry dog, pea-size treats, "Jackpot" (super yummiie) treats, favorite toy, bait bag, clicker, leash & buckle collar.

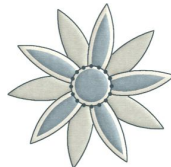
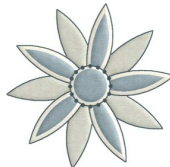
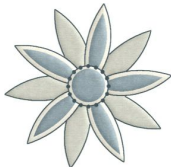

Capital Kennel Club of Juneau (CKCoJ) MONTHLY MEETING
March 21, 2013
Downtown Library Small Conference Room, 6:30pm

- I. Call to Order at 6:33pm. Board members present: Mike Higgs, Sandy Harris, Carol Lemon, George Utermohle, Sue McGowan. Other member present: Camille Stephens.

- II. Consent agenda
 - A. Approval of the agenda: Mike Higgs added B. UKC trial scheduling to IV. Discussion Items; Mike moved item A. from IV. Discussion Items, to III. Action Items, B. Camille Stephens added item C. Fun Match fees to Discussion Items. Agenda was then approved by Unanimous Consent (U/C).
 - B. Approval of the minutes from previous meeting, 2/21/2013: approved by U/C.
 - C. Acceptance of the treasurer's report: George provided a to-date report for February, 2012 and revised reports for August, November and December, 2012. Sue made a motion to accept the treasurer's report(s), Sandy seconded- motioned passed by U/C.
 - D. Approval of new members: Georgene Wallin, Karen Boddy, Cheryl and Joseph Adelmeyer, Julie Coffin-approved by U/C.

- III. Action Items
 - A. Approve/disapprove fee matrix changes: the following changes to the CKCoJ Fee Matrix were approved by U/C: 1) non-member rate for classes was increased by \$5.00; the following item was added to the fee matrix: 4-hour class fee rate of \$50 for non-members, \$40 class fee rate for members; 2) drop-in rate for all practices, including conformation, changed to \$10 from current amount; 3) maximum number of participants for classes and practices will be determined by and at the discretion of the instructor, coordinator, or facilitator. 4) review of the fee matrix to be scheduled in 2015 failed to pass, as follows: 1 yes, 5 no.
 - B. Field storage unit for Agility activities at Melvin Park (carryover): The board approved expenditures of \$600 to rent, transport, set up and insure a container van at Melvin Park to be used for storing Agility equipment for the summer of 2013.

 - B. UKC trial scheduling: it was decided to pursue an Obedience and Rally Obedience trial in October, 2013 as the deadline for a September trial is April 1st, depending on getting volunteers for trial sec'ty, chair, etc.
 - C. Fun Match fees: past philosophy has been to make fun matches affordable to encourage participation; current fee is \$5 per run. Discussion ensued about charging \$7 per run- no change to fee at this time.

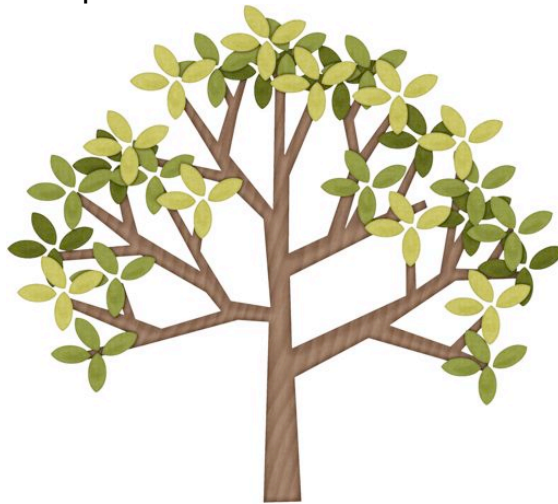
