DRAFT MINUTES
Capital Kennel Club of Juneau (CKCoJ) MONTHLY MEETING
June 20, 2013
Downtown Library Small Conference Room, 6:30pm

- I. Call to Order: 6:40pm. Board members present: George Utermohle, Carol Lemon, Sandy Harris, Sue McGowan, Mike Higgs. General members present: none.
- II. Consent agenda
 - A. Approval of the agenda: approved by Unanimous Consent (U/C).
 - B. Approval of the minutes from previous meeting, 5/16/2013: **Change-** Jill Taylor's name will be removed from list of new members as her application was a renewal; May minutes (with change as noted) then approved by U/C.
 - C. Acceptance of the treasurer's report: approved by U/C.
 - D. Approval of new members: none
- III. Action Items
 - A. Reimbursement cost and shipping/insurance for judges gift (Sue): reimbursement check issued.
 - B. Possible dates f/annual meeting at Riverbend AHFC rec room: meeting date set for Sunday, October 6.
 - C. Board Member Vacancy: Carol Lemon will leave Juneau next Saturday for new job in Fairbanks. Nominating committee (see below IV., item B) will search for replacement for Carol's position to fill out her term.
- IV. Discussion Items
 - A. Aging Equipment Replacement (mats & ring gates)- carryover: tabled for future discussion concerning needing additional funds before replacement.
 - B. Nominating Committee- carryover: Mike Higgs, Sue McGowan (Chair) agreed to serve on the nominating committee. Sue will verify that Susan Hoffman agreed to be on the committee as well. There will be three current board positions to fill and a replacement to serve out Carol's term.
 - C. Juneau Community Schools: George presented some of the new regulations and pricing for Community Schools facilities that will be in effect as of July, 2013.
 - D. Agility Equipment- discussion centered on new NADAC requirements for weave poles to be spaced 24-in. apart and the cost for replacing the current club weave poles that have 22-in. pole spacing. Mike reported on pricing from T&S Welding (local) and pricing from Affordable Agility (New York). 6 bases (bases only- no poles) from T&S will cost approx. \$224.00 for materials and welding- CKCoJ would have to buy the poles and caps, assemble them, and apply a coating. Affordable Agility prices are approx. \$270.00 for a complete 6 pole set, including shipping. Essentially, the cost for 24 complete pole sets (plus shipping) from Affordable Agility would be approx. the same as manufacturing locally 24 bases only, with CKCoJ having to buy and assemble and then paint the poles to make a complete set. No decision made at this time. Carryover.

V. Routine Updates/Reports

A. Event planning

- 1) Obedience/Rally: upcoming trials in August and November, 2013
- 2) Agility: upcoming trial July 27-28, 2013
- 3) Classes/practices: Mike sent out survey about interest in a beginner Rally class and had just 4 responses from people indicating interest; not enough for a class.
- 4) Workshops and Seminars: Susan Perry (Agility judge) will hold a workshop the day before the trial.

B. Committee Reports/Updates: none.

C. Correspondence: Mike talked to the manager at Petco, who agreed to put up an edited version of a CKCoJ poster/flyer somewhere in the store, so long as the information didn't conflict with any Petco activities.

VI. Next meeting: no quorum for July 18, 2013 meeting. Sue will see if Small Conference room is available on July 11th, if not, July meeting will be cancelled.

- Weekends (F-Sun and Holidays, \$18/hour)

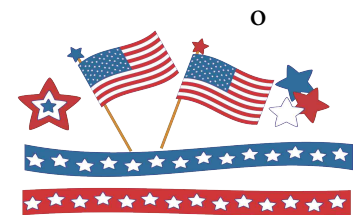
Processing fee \$10/permit

o Rental rates:

- Middle School Commons (\$7/hr)
- Covered Playgrounds (\$5/hr)

Miscellaneous Requirements ...

- o Provide JCS a copy of our IRS non-profit status letter
- o Liability insurance of \$1M to protect JCS
- o JCS may cancel a permit with only a 24-hour notification
- o Currently school activity can cancel our reservation
