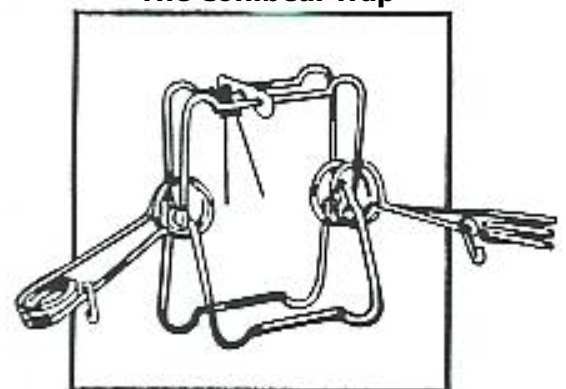

## III. Action Items:

- A. Cost of Practices: Questions have been raised on the fee schedule for the Competition Obedience class being held at Mt. Jumbo. After discussion it was suggested to follow the preset class fee schedule. Accepted by U/C.
- B. Awards: Mike Higgs raised the need for pins and zipper pulls for end of year awards. Mike will order five pins / five zipper pulls for Level 3 Rally-O awards. Not more than \$100 dollars will be authorized for award purchases now and other ordering will be revisited in August after the trial - once the need is apparent.

## IV. Discussion Items:

- A. Hazel's Puppy and Manners Classes
  - 1) Discussion of raising class prices to reflect the increase in rental prices for the use of school facilities that have happened over the past several years. Should class prices be raised to keep pace with expenses?
  - 2) Discussion of changing member discount level to reduce the gap between: "the total cost of a membership plus a member discounted class fee" as compared to "the nonmember class fee". Point made that members should have doggie dollars from volunteering that would help bring down class fees for members even without a large "member's discount".
  - 3) Discussion of how the ability to register for classes online with credit card payments can fit in with the need for instructor pre-approval for class enrollment.

All three discussion items are held over for further discussion at next meeting.
